


ZC-60R thru ZC-66P Craftsman hammered knobs. Lost Wax cast brass knobs, plated copper and mellow



This furniture and cabinet hardware is completely made by hand, from solid copper sheet and rod. Hundreds of hammer blows and great skill are used for each piece. Due to the hand made nature of the patterns, no two pieces of hardware will have identical patterns.


Craftsmen Field pattern copper small pulls. Both plates 1 7/8" by 2 3/4"; Ring: 1 11/16" diameter. All solid copper supplied with round head screws.

ZC-7RH & ZC-8RV

Craftsmen Field pattern copper small pulls. Both plates 1 1/4" by 2 1/4";Ring: 1 5/16" diameter. All solid copper supplied with round head screws

Field Pattern Switch Plates and Doorbell

Single switch plates & doorbell (2 3/4" x 4 1/2") and double switch plates (4 1/2" by 4 1/2") are shown below. Choose the plate for your application. Outside sizes might vary a tiny bit with the hand hammering technique, but it will not affect the precisely placed switch holes.

These nice handle types are all

the same sized backplate which is 1 1/4" by 4". All solid copper supplied w/-round head screws

ZC-46RH

Nice two part Field pattern recessed handle. Both parts are made from copper and mount separately as well. Plate size: 1 5/8" x 4" Recessed section is:

1" x 2 1/4" by 1/2"deep ZC-48FC & ZC-50SH & ZC-58RV & ZC-114RH

These nice larger style handles all have the same sized backplates which is 1 5/8" by 4". All solid copper supplied with round head screws

Field Pattern:

It is a little different than Hammered Pattern, only insomuch as the hammering of the backplate is contained within a "field" isolated in the center of the plate. Heavy scribe lines form the border of this "field" and the pattern has a more structured look to it than the random and all over Hammered pattern.

Mounting is also different. While the Hammered Pattern uses the pyramid nails, Field Pattern uses small round headed wood screws which mimic-

Since all of these plate are hand hammered, the outside sizes of the plates might change slightly due to the continued hammer blows to form the pattern. This also happened with the original Arts and Crafts pieces. After all, this is the definitions of hand worked Arts and Crafts.
